

SPONSOR YOUR Healthcare Professional

Our Twelfth Step and our Fifth Tradition both speak to us of carrying the message to the Alcoholic who still suffers. How better to make ourselves available, than to insure that those who come in contact with suffering Alcoholics are aware of what AA is, and what AA is not?

There is no "Promotion" involved, as protected by our Eleventh Tradition. On the contrary, this committee serves to inform and explain our Traditions to those outside of AA. If we start with our own Healthcare Providers, we would then know that at least our own Provider knows.
